About This Course

The purpose of the **FINEOS Configuration Studio** course is to provide non-technical attendees with an understanding of the configuration capabilities of the FINEOS application. This is done by working with the configuration functions in the FINEOS GUI.

This two and a half day instructor-led course provides trainees with the skills to configure and route work throughout the FINEOS system. Trainees will be able to define and automate business processes. In addition this course details how to configure electronic case files to meet various business requirements, including how to configure claim case types.

Course Objectives

After completing this course, trainees will gain the skills to:

- Set up a company structure including departments and users
- Create and manage user accounts for the FINEOS application
- Manage drop-down lists (FINEOS enums)
- Configure work item templates (FINEOS task types)
- Configure automated workflow (FINEOS process types)
- Configure electronic case files (FINEOS case types)
- Configure claim case files (FINEOS claim case types)
