FINEOS is a highly configurable system that you can configure to suit your organization's requirements. This module explains each of the UI elements that you can configure, the different configuration methods available, how to use the UI Config Mode facility, and how to control access to UI elements.

<b>Introduction</b>	FINEOS is a highly configurable system that can be configured to suit an organizations requirements.
<b>About the configuration methods</b>	This module provides a high level overview of the different components available to configure the FINEOS UI elements to suit business needs. The difference between production mode and non-production mode is highlighted while contrasting UI configuration methods via: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• FINEOS UI</li> <li>• XML configuration files</li> </ul>
<b>Using the UI Config mode</b>	This module informs candidates of the required information to configure FINEOS UI elements including business rules, widgets, listviews, treeviews, pages, and toolbars.
<b>Controlling access to UI elements</b>	Access to UI elements can be controlled by assigning generic secured actions, using contexts, having a hide and disable property in an application category and triggering events on UI elements.
