

COURSE OUTLINE – (FTB-F-012) FINEOS CONFIGURATION FILES

About this course

FINEOS Insurance Platform features and UI may be configured through a number of XML files. In non-production mode you can easily override certain core configurations where necessary while maintaining default settings where appropriate. The FINEOS Configuration Files course covers these features.

Course objectives

The purpose of this course is to provide candidates with an understanding of the configuration capabilities of the FINEOS application by means of manipulation and management of the different XML settings within the FINEOS application.

After completing this course, trainees will gain the skills to:

- Distinguish between Application and Customizer configuration files
- Distinguish between Product and Custom configuration files
- Configure widgets
- Configure list views
- Configure tree views
- Configure screens
- Configure tabs
- Configure toolbar icons

Introduction	Introduces customizer configuration files which enable candidates to		
	configure the elements on the UI that cannot be configured using Screen		
	Customizer and Configuration Manager.		
Using the XML	The customizer configuration files allow you to configure tabs, toolbars,		
configuration files	and extra attributes for widgets and screens in FINEOS.		
Default and custom	This module introduces candidates to the product configuration files and		
configuration files	explains how to override the product configuration with custom XML		
	configuration files.		
Widget Configuration	When FINEOS is running in non-production mode, you can only make		
	configuration changes using the XML configuration files. Candidates will		
	be introduced to widget configuration via the FINEOS XML configuration		
	files.		
Configuring screens	This modules enables candidates to configure screens using the		
	customizer screen configuration XML files, for example, applying a		
	custom .jsp file, changing screen titles and controlling access to screens		
Configuring tabs	This modules enables candidates to configure tabs using the customizer		
	tab configuration XML files.		
Configuring toolbar icons	Toolbar configuration files enable candidates to perform the following		
	tasks for example, hiding toolbar icons, changing a toolbar icon graphic,		
	editing the text in a tooltip.
